Leadline & Walk – Open to riders 10 and younger who have not shown at the trot in previous shows **NO ENTRY FEE FOR THIS CLASS**

Walk Trot/Poles – Open to junior and amateur riders who have not shown at the canter in previous shows. May not cross enter into another section.

Crossrails – Open to juniors and amateurs who have not jumped higher than 18" in previous shows. May trot or canter course. Flat phase is walk/trot/canter.

Short/Long Stirrup Hunter 18" – Open to juniors and amateurs in their first years of showing.

Baby Green Hunter 2' – Open to all horses/ponies in their first year of showing. May trot or canter course. Horses may be ridden by professionals

14 & Under/ 15 & Over Equitation classes – Open to junior/amateurs. May only enter equitation one section at this show.

TF Childrens/Adult Medal Class 2'3"- 2'6" – Open to juniors/amateurs. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences including at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors is required. The same horse must be used in all phases, only one rider per horse. No equipment changes once the class has begun. Top four riders will be invited to participate in the finals

Limit Rider Hunter 2' – Open to juniors/amateurs who have not won six blue ribbons in jumping classes of 2' or higher.

Hopeful Hunter 2'3" – Open to horses/ponies, may not cross enter into any classes higher than 2'3" at this show.

Pony Hunter choice of fence height 2' or 2'6" Open to juniors on ponies.

Modified Childrens/Adult Hunter 2'6"- Open to juniors and amateurs.

TF Hunter Derby – 2'3" – 2'6" – majority of fences to be 2'3" This class will consist of two rounds, a classic round combined with a handy round to determine the winner. **ALL HORSES** will jog for soundness. Order of go will be set and followed for both rounds. The purpose of the Derby is: To bring the basic principles of riding back into show hunters through the use of challenging courses, interesting jump materials and greater variation in fence construction • To create a "Grand Prix" for show hunters • To bring hunter and jumper riders together again at the top level. If five entries complete both courses, prize money will be awarded. \$20. 1st, \$12 2nd, \$8 3rd, \$4 4th, R, R

Schooling Friday afternoon and Saturday morning until 9:00 There will be **no schooling** on the outside course. **NO DOGS PLEASE!!! Good concessions on grounds, bring a lawn chair.**
